



TR2. Rovos Rail Pretoria to Victoria Falls (or vice versa) – 2 nights

DAY-TO-DAY ITINERARY:

PRETORIA – VICTORIA FALLS

Day 1 Depart Pretoria

At 10h00 depart from Rovos Rail's gracious station in Capital Park Pretoria on a two night three day 1600 kilometre adventure through varied and truly African scenery. Guests may freshen up in their suites before joining fellow travellers in the midway Lounge car or Observation carriage at the rear of the train. Lunch is served while en route to Zeerust. Enjoy the afternoon relaxing. Dinner is served in the graciously restored dining car/s at 19h30.

Day 2

Breakfast is served in the dining car/s from 07h00 to 09h45. Once in Botswana the train heads north towards Mahalapye, crossing the Tropic of Capricorn just after Gaborone. Once the train has passed through the dry reaches of Botswana we arrive at Plumtree in the late afternoon for border formalities with Zimbabwe. Lunch and dinner is served in the dining car/s.

Day 3 Arrive Victoria Falls

We continue in a north-westerly direction passing Bulawayo heading towards Thompson's Junction and Hwange Game Reserve where animals can be spotted from the train. During the afternoon we have a service stop at Thompson Junction after which your sojourn ends at approximately 17h00 at the incomparable Victoria Falls.

VICTORIA FALLS - PRETORIA

Day 1 Depart Victoria Falls

This relaxing train journey departs at 10h00 from Victoria Falls. Guests may freshen up in their suites before joining other guests in the midway Lounge car or the Observation carriage at the rear of the train. 13h00 Lunch will be served in the dining car/s. Afternoon free to relax either in your suite or the observation car. Dinner is served in the dining car/s.

Day 2

Breakfast will be served in the dining car from 07h00 until 10h00, followed by lunch, which is served in the dining car/s at 13h00. Border formalities from Zimbabwe to Botswana are done in Plumtree. Dinner is served in the dining car/s.

Day 3 Arrive in Pretoria

Breakfast will be served in the dining car until 10h00. The train continues the journey towards Pretoria passing through Zeerust Krugersdorp, Johannesburg and Germiston. Arrival at Rovos Rail Station in Capital Park, Pretoria, at around 17h00.

Please note that depending upon railway capacity this journey could be routed northwards through Beitbridge and Zimbabwe.
